

THE OPERATION 22 TO ZERO HERO MOBILE TO ARRIVE IN PUNTA GORDA APRIL 17TH

{Offers Hope to Service Members, Veterans and First Responders}

"Today Matters Mental Health Ministries," a new program, whose mission is to help remove the stigma about mental health by connecting the mind, spirit, body and to be the voice for the silent, has invited Michele Ladd and the Operation 22 to Zero Hero Mobile to participate in the Today Matters Ministry on April 17th.

"We are very excited Ms. Ladd and the National Veteran Resources organization will take part in our ministry," said Briyin Butgereit. The Hero Mobile will be parked in front of the Life Center on the church's campus.

Since September 11, 2018, the Hero Mobile has traveled to more than 30 States and more than 85,000 miles reaching thousands of heroes. Their mission is to offer hope and help for Service Members, Veterans and First Responders. They do this by traveling the country in the Operation 22 to ZERO Hero Mobile meeting America's heroes face to face, sharing their stories and finding local resources if they need help. Their goal is to reduce suicide by letting them know they care and that they are not alone!


Thank you to everyone who is checking in online for their attendance. And don't forget name tags, either the magnetic ones or hand written options.

The Eighth Note – Music Ministry in a Minute!



Greetings Everyone,

Do you know the famous hymn written by Charles Wesley in 1739 that didn't make it into our Methodist hymnals in a form we would recognize until 1935?!?!?

The hymn is "Christ The Lord Is Risen Today", which was first published under the title "Hymn for Easterday" in Charles Wesley's *Hymns and Sacred Poems*, 1739. It

originally had eleven stanzas (this is back when people went to church all day) and no Alleluias (church could be very serious business back then). The British Methodist Hymnal adopted the hymn in 1831 with "Hallelujahs" added to the text. The American Methodist Hymnal adopted the hymn in 1849. It was not until 1935 that the American Methodist Hymnal changed the "Hallelujahs" to "Alleluias" and paired the text to the tune we know today, "Easter Hymn".


