The Cleansing Process of Hurricane Helene & Milton.

In 5 Buildings: Polluted Water followed by Polluted Water and Muck!

Rooms 8-13: (Music Rooms, Room 9, Nursery Rooms 11 & 12, Room 13 Pastor Bob's Office and Prayer Room)

Lenox Hall, Church Office, Bargain Boutique & Sanctuary.

Lost all furniture, materials, some equipment.

Lost 6 air conditioning unit that will be replaced. 2 others need repaired.

All dry wall & insulation had to be cut from floor up 4 feet. All baseboards.

Phone System has to be replaced.

Some Communications gear needs to be replaced or repaired.

To date 15 large dumpsters filled.

Tables, chairs, desks, wiring, file cabinets, storage shelves & boxes

Carpeting, dry wall, baseboards, electronic equipment, phone system

Will slowly replace lost equipment, furniture, materials and supplies.

A complete Cleansing all Rooms but the Sanctuary and Life Center

Sanctuary

- Some water on floor. From floor vents.
- Within 10 hours of each storm, Bob Miller had crews in drying out the building.
- Everything has been cleaned, top to bottom by our volunteers.
- Air Conditioning Duct work under the Sanctuary will be replaced.
- Wiring for Communications under the Sanctuary needs to be adjusted.
- Presently testing for the Drywood Termites.
- Currently unable to broadcast from the Sanctuary.

Nursery, Music, Rooms 9 & 13, Pastor Bob & Prayer Room

- All Furniture, File Cabinets, Equipment, and Supplies lost.
- The goal has been to get these rooms renovated first.
- Decision on type of flooring replacement.
- Music room lost older piano, sheet music & supplies.
- Room 9 completely gutted, lost new cabinets, tore out wall cabinets.
- Room 13 lost all reading material and most equipment.
- Nursery lost all furniture, carpeting, supplies, etc.
- Pastor Bob had to clean his office out! Prayer Room gone.
- All rooms have been dried and prepped, ready for drywall and finishes.
- 5 new Air Conditioning Units are on their way for this area.
- Mounted on the outside walls.
- Timetable to be determined as to installation and final renovation of all spaces.

Lenox Hall

- Whatever Helene missed; Milton got!
- All furniture, equipment, materials, and storage items gone.
- Old Place Settings & Other Dishes gone.
- Storage units and presentation equipment gone.
- Gutted out ready for dry wall and painting.
- Flooring will need to be replaced in the future.
- Will finish off main room for basic meetings.
- Kitchen area needs to be cleaned, coolers need to be replaced.
- Eventually, construct new storage area in back of room.
- Timetable to be determined in next 10 days.

Church Office

- Lost all furniture, file cabinets, supplies, some records.
- Completely gutted the facility.
- Lost new printer/copier machine. Lease Value \$50,000.
- Lost network equipment that supplied the campus.
- Lost phone system equipment for the campus.
- Will replace some dry wall and paint.
- Air Conditioner still works!
- Presently have no plans to return staff to this facility.
- Will be used for storage, most likely by the Bargain Boutique.

Bargain Boutique

- Lost 95% of their inventory.
- Interior of house completely gutted.
- Lost significant equipment, supplies, furniture.
- Will take out interior wall to give more retail space.
- Had planned on renovation of garage and house. Halted.
- New air conditioning unit will be repaired.
- Garage also flooded.
- Short term. Boutique will use Church Office for storage and sorting.
- Interior walls will be insulated and dry walled. Flooring to be determined.
- Will operate out of their facility, but no updates to the facility for the short term.

Have received \$90,000 in donations. \$36,000 from the Sanctification Network. \$54,000 from individual donors.

Use of unrestricted **Non-Foundational** Funds.

Maybe settlement from insurance company for Ian Claims still in progress of completing. Last estimate was \$377,000.

The Cleansing of our Buildings provides us with an opportunity to begin with a Clean Slate and to move our church forward in what God wants us to do for His Kingdom!
